

## Aramark Program Information:

We currently are able to work at Conseco, Verizon, or Victory Fields for events. A schedule is sent out for dates and times for your review. You will then sign up with myself for those events that you choose. I in turn submit a worker total to these venues and they approve or decline depending upon the response from other Non-profit organizations. Therefore, the sooner you let me know the events you can work, the better our chances of our group being able to participate.

Each of the above venues pays a percentage of what is sold by our group at the event. They then send us a check, and I send you emails as far as what you earned. We then send you a spreadsheet to show what is in your child's account. These funds can then be used for fees, travel, or anything soccer related (with a receipt).

In order to work these events you must take a class called TIPS/ATC (for Verizon & Victory Field) which is about a 2 hour class held at a designated location. This class is mandatory PRIOR to you working any of the venue events. It teaches you the do's and don'ts of serving alcohol. There is normally (1) class held per month. You must also apply for a liquor license. This application is found on the Indiana.gov website on the left hands side under forms. (the cost is \$15.00 for the volunteer one) As long as you have a copy of your application for the liquor license along with the copy of the money order sent, the liquor license does not need to be **received** before working.

You must be 21 or older to work the venue events. For Victory Field, you need to wear a plain white polo shirt, khaki slacks, capris or shorts since it is outside, plus a black visor. Verizon and Victory Field, you can wear tennis shoes. At Verizon, you wear Khaki slacks, capris, or shorts PLUS they provide you with one of their Aramark shirts. (you pick that shirt up the first day you work there. )

Conseco is run by Levvy Restraunts, so they too have a class similar to the TIPS class. The normal dress attire at Conseco is BLACK slacks, they provide your shirt when you get there, and you then leave it when you are finished, **black non-skid shoes**, and they have a Conseco hat to wear that you purchase once for \$12.00

**\*\*\*NOTE: If you sign up for an event, and something prevents you from working that event, you MUST cancel 72 hours prior in order to prevent a \$65.00 penalty, that would be deducted from your club account. If for some reason it is the day before or day of, due to unforeseen circumstances, we can TRY to find a replacement. If this is the case, it is important that you contact me by phone to get this done. (317-332-3973) There are no guarantees, but we have several families that participate on a regular basis, and we can try to get that filled.**

FC PRIDE events, we offer an opportunity to work the concession stand in 3 hour shifts. These opportunities are during tournaments. This pays \$10.00 an hour or \$30.00 per shift to be applied to your child's Aramark account.
