Itinerary Outline for
FC PRIDE

*Training & Sightseeing/Barcelona, Spain; Donosti Cup Tournament/San Sebastian, Spain.
June 30-July 11, 2010.*

June 30: Depart Indianapolis for overnight journey to Barcelona, Spain. After connecting in a US gateway city, arrival in Barcelona will be in the morning of the next day.

July 1: Upon arrival in Barcelona, and after clearing Spanish Customs and Immigration, your group will be met by a local representative and a privately chartered bus. Your local representative and privately chartered bus will be on hand on a full time basis, insuring that your stay in the area goes smoothly. You will be transferred to your accommodations, a tourist class hotel located near the city center. Here the players will be accommodated in triple rooms, and any adults and boosters accompanying the group will be in double or single rooms, as needed. All rooms will have private bathroom and shower facilities. A daily buffet breakfast will be included for all travelers at the hotel.

After checking in and unpacking, you will meet your local representative and have the chance to explore the city on your own for the remainder of the afternoon and evening.

July 2: After breakfast the group will have a tour of [Barcelona](#). The tour will include the Cathedral, the Gothic Quarter, Generalitat, the Town Hall, Las Ramblas, and the Olympic Village, among other sights. Following the tour there will be free time in the city for shopping, lunch and relaxing.

Later in the afternoon the group will transfer to the famous [Camp Nou Stadium](#), home of the professional team FC Barcelona. The stadium itself is a tourist attraction, with a capacity of 115,000. There is also an FC Barcelona museum and shop connected to the stadium, and you will have some time here as well.

In the evening you might enjoy an excursion to one of the many lively night spots for dinner. Since you will have access to the bus on a full time basis, the possibilities are endless.

July 3: the morning will be free to relax and do some additional sightseeing or shopping on your own.

In the afternoon you will transfer to a local club where each FC Pride team will play a friendly match against a local team.

July 4: In the morning the group will check out of the hotel and load up the bus for the transfer to San Sebastian. We will plan a stop for lunch and some informal sightseeing in [Zaragosa](#), about half way.

The seaside resort of [San Sebastian](#) is the home of the [Donosti Cup](#) tournament. Your group will arrive at the tournament headquarters for check in and then be taken to your accommodations.

Players and staff will be staying at a local university located near the center of San Sebastian, the [Colegio Mayor Olarain](#). You will be in a residence hall on campus, in single or double rooms as needed. Three meals each day will be provided for all travelers, with breakfasts served cafeteria style in the residence hall and lunches and dinners at the tournament restaurant. Once again the group will have a privately chartered bus available on a full time basis to handle all ground transportation needs conveniently and in comfort. Adults and boosters who accompany the group will have the option to stay at a nearby hotel in San Sebastian, if desired.

July 5-10: The Donosti Cup tournament has earned a reputation as one of Europe's premier youth tournaments. With an emphasis on quality both on and off the playing fields, this tournament offers a tremendous experience for anyone who participates. For the Donosti Cup 2010, 200 teams from 20 different soccer playing nations are expected. All teams are guaranteed a minimum of four games during the tournament, which is played at several sites in and around the city of San Sebastian. Teams are bracketed in groups of 4, and after playing each other, the next phase of the tournament begins. The top two teams from each group advance in the tournament, and the third and fourth place teams from each group continue play in a consolation tournament. The tournament begins on July 5 with the first games and impressive Opening Ceremonies at the local professional team's stadium. The event comes to a close with the finals which are played on Saturday, July 10.

There will be time for some sightseeing excursions to local points of interest during the tournament week, to be determined with the help of your representative. The city of San Sebastian itself offers some great sightseeing opportunities. It is a picturesque resort city located in the heart of [Basque country](#) in northeastern Spain. With spectacular vistas overlooking the Bay of Biscay to the west and surrounded by lush green hills in every other direction, San Sebastian offers a unique and beautiful backdrop for the Donosti Cup tournament. You will see the historic Old Town, the Harbor area, and the Mount Urgull area overlooking the city.

Another opportunity for an excursion during the week is to the city of [Biarritz](#), France. Originally settled as a whaling town, Biarritz is now a French seaside resort. You are sure to enjoy a walk along the boardwalk on the beach, and simply walking around the city. On the way back you can stop for lunch in the small but quaint fishing village of [St. Jean de Luz](#).

July 11: After eleven days of soccer, sightseeing and fun it will be time to return to the USA. A privately chartered bus will transport the group to the airport in nearby Bilbao, where you board a connecting flight back to the USA, connecting through Madrid and Chicago before landing in Indianapolis.

Prices per person:

Players/Staff: \$3,299.00

Adults/Boosters: \$3,569.00*

*This price reflects double occupancy in the hotel in Barcelona, and hotel accommodations in San Sebastian (double occupancy). Please note: for single occupancy add an additional \$65.00 per person, per night.

The prices noted for the above outline itinerary includes the following:

- Round trip airfare as noted via regularly scheduled carrier from Indianapolis-Barcelona and from Bilbao to Indianapolis.
- Privately chartered motor coach available on a full time basis from July 1-July 4 in Barcelona, transfer from Barcelona to San Sebastian on July 4, and from July 4 through July 11 in San Sebastian.
- Accommodations for ten nights (July 1-July 11) as noted; in a tourist class hotel (3 star minimum) in Barcelona for 3 nights (July 1-4) and a residence hall at the Colegio Mayor Olarain at the Donosti Cup for 7 nights (July 4-11). All rooms will have private bathrooms and shower facilities.
- Daily breakfasts for all group members in Barcelona; three meals daily in San Sebastian.
- Full sports program to include one friendly game for each team in Barcelona as noted, and participation in the appropriate age group of the Donosti Cup tournament.
- Services of a local representative for your group at each stop.
- Pre-trip assistance and administration from East-West Global Travel.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

Tour Cost: The price per traveler for the FC Pride tour of Spain as outlined is \$3,299.00 (players, triple occupancy) or \$3,569.00 (double occupancy). In order to make this as manageable as possible for you, and also to enable us to make financial commitments on your behalf to our various overseas suppliers, we have devised a schedule of payments which divides this amount equally over the next several months.

Deposit: A deposit of \$300.00 per traveler will be required to hold and confirm a place on tour. This deposit is 100% non refundable should you decide to cancel your participation at a later date. Of course, this deposit will be credited fully towards the cost of your trip.

Suggested Payment Schedule: Once the deposit has been received, the remaining balance due will be split into four equal payments, with the final payment being due by May 24, 2010. A summary of the payment schedule is as follows:

Due with registration (December 1, 2009):	\$300.00
Due January 15, 2010:	\$749.75
Due March 1, 2010:	\$749.75
Due April 15, 2010:	\$749.75
Due May 24, 2010:	\$749.75

Credit Card Payments: Credit card payments with either VISA or MASTERCARD will be accepted for any fees associated with the tour.

Cancellation and Refund Policy: As a general rule, please note that we will always endeavor to refund to any player as much money as is retrievable at the time of cancellation. However, because we are bound by the restrictions imposed upon us by suppliers such as airlines, ground operators, etc., we need to make sure that you also are aware of the cancellation fees involved. If a traveler withdraws from the tour after money has been paid to East-West Global Travel, the following fees will apply:

If cancellation is prior to April 15, 2010, there will be no penalty other than the forfeit of the deposit, which is non-refundable from the time of receipt.

If cancellation is between April 16 and May 24, 2010, all monies paid to East-West Global Travel will be refunded, less the deposit and a \$300.00 cancellation fee (\$600.00 total per person).

If cancellation is after May 24, 2010, no refunds will be available.

Deviation Charges: Deviations from the main (group) itinerary are welcome and normally easily accomplished if reasonable prior notice is given. Until April 1, 2010, any and all requests for deviations will be dealt with at no charge (other than the actual difference in whatever plans are to be made). After this date, there will be a charge of \$75.00 per person for any deviation from the main itinerary, in addition to the normal charges incurred.

Trip Cancellation Insurance: In order to protect yourself against the penalties outlined above, in addition to any unforeseen circumstances that might cause you to withdraw from the tour, we recommend trip cancellation insurance. If you would like more information about this, please contact the East-West Global Travel office.

Responsibility and Liability: The responsibility of East-West Global Travel, the foreign ground operators, tournament organizers, and host organizations is limited. East-West Global Travel acts in the capacity of an agent for the participants in all matters pertaining to the tour, such as (but not limited to) the arrangement of transportation, accommodations, meals, sightseeing, social and cultural activities, and the sports program. East-West Global Travel, its suppliers, foreign tournament organizers and hosting organizations including host clubs are not responsible for any personal injury, illness or death, nor any loss, damage or theft of belongings, nor for any error, accident, delay, deviation or curtailment of any kind caused directly by any actions, omissions, acts of failure by:

- a) Any person or company retained for the benefit of the participant, including, but not limited to transportation, housing, and tour guides;
- b) Acts of God, public enemy, arrest or restraint by any government, seizure under legal process, quarantine restrictions, riots of civil commotions, strikes, lockouts or labor stoppages, war hazards or dangers incident to the state of war;
- c) Any defect or failure to comply with any part of local rules or regulations of any airplane, automobile, motor coach, ship, train, or other vehicle.
- d) Improper or insufficient passports or other documents.

Additional expense incurred under any of these circumstances will be the sole responsibility of the tour participants.

General: East-West Global Travel will assume that the responsible tour leader, participants and their parents or legal guardians, are in agreement with the conditions mentioned above, and that all engagements with East-West Global Travel have been undertaken by an authorized person. These conditions are applicable to all agreements between East-West Global Travel and any party.
